THE PROJECT

The project "Mitigating Adverse Effects of Internal Migration" is implemented by the International Organization for Migration (IOM) funded by IOM Development Fund in cooperation with the Ministry for Population Policy and Demography (MPPD) and Serbian Commissariat for Refugees and Migration (SCRM). This project aims to support the mainstreaming of selected national priorities, focusing on internal migration of youth, into local sector planning, thus aligning migration with key development priorities, through strengthened vertical coordination and targeted capacity building for this exercise.

Ivanjica	"Innovative youth employment program"	Development and implementation of "Innovative youth employment program" which is designed for young people and operates in the area of employment and self-employment through the Work Practice Program and trainings on several topics: writing business plans, legal services and issues, subsidizing youth self-employment programs, training for web promotion of business.
Kikinda	"Development of preschool capacities in Kikinda"	Creation of measures for reconciling work and parenting through childcare of working parents. Contribution to improve the safety of the children who reside in kindergartens and creation of conditions for a pleasant and more productive stay.
Knjazevac	"Become a citizen of Knjazevac"	Project will address one of the biggest problems in this municipality, the demographical problem and the low fertile base. As a pilot project, this will be just the beginning of the action on the large scale in which the municipality is planning to give all the residential buildings in public ownership for usage to the citizens of Serbia which are ready to come to live permanently, or to stay to live in Knjazevac.
Prokuplje	"Mitigating the adverse consequences of internal migrations through implementation of professional qualifications training and reduction of unemployment"	The proposed project activities aim to support unemployed people who need to gain new skills and improve knowledge to find a suitable job. Through a planned education and training young people would gain the knowledge and practical skills. They would be able to find a work and stay in the local community.
