Within the project "EU Support to Migration Management in Serbia – Improving reception capacity, protection services and access to education III" under the overall supervision of Head of Office and under the direct supervision of the Project Coordinator the incumbents will be responsible for the following tasks:

- To share relevant information to beneficiaries and/or between beneficiaries and Serbian Commissariat for Refugees and Migration (SCRM)
- To assist and support all field activities in the centers in coordination with SCRM field staff
- To report to Project Coordinator and Project Assistant all activities carried out in the centers;

- To be able to move among centers as per needs identified (South/North/West and East Serbia)
- To assist in every day camp activities, including assistance provided to migrants as well as the government staff in charge for camp management;
- To maintain close communication and coordination with other IOM field members, SCRM field staff and other relevant stakeholders present in the centers
- Perform such other duties as may be assigned by Project Coordinator and HoO
